Interim: Student Traveler's Covenant

By my signature below, I do covenant and promise to honor my group leader's trust, and the trust of the CCS authorities, in the following ways:

I agree to make choices that reflect a sincere desire to uphold the peace and purity of this trip and to refrain from involvement in any conduct that is detrimental to me, others in our group, or Chattanooga Christian School. I do so with a clear understanding that this trip is a wonderful privilege that has been afforded to me. I therefore agree to comply with the standards and expectations of CCS as explained in the Parent and Student Handbook. Below are several specific policies that can affect the productivity and success of this trip for me and others.

I agree to submit to the authority of our trip leader in all matters of travel including but not limited to the limits and boundaries regarding trip movement, compliance with designated meeting times at various trip stops, and all designated hotel room times.

I agree to hold to hours of curfew and lights out requirements. My chaperons will be taking precautionary measures to ensure my safety and well being for the evening and I will in no way disrupt the trip or do dishonor to my chaperon by violating these expectations.

I agree to submit to all CCS policies regarding drug, alcohol, and tobacco use and the purchase thereof.

I agree to submit to CCS policy regarding the physical display of affection toward others.

I agree to submit to CCS policy, and wear clothing that is both modest and appropriate.

I agree to be respectful toward all persons and conduct myself in an upright manner. This would include not just fellow CCS travelers and strangers but also taking into consideration the laws and social conventions of the place of travel.

Should I become aware of any violation of the above statements, including those in the Parent Student Handbook, I will report this information to my group leader immediately.

Consequences

Failure of students to adhere to CCS polices and procedures likely will lead to a one semester probationary period. The implications are that those involved in extra curricular activities will forfeit participation in these opportunities (athletics / drama) for one semester beginning on the first date the consequences for their actions are rendered.

Forfeit all overnight CCS trips for a period of one year.

If in the judgment of the principal or the parent (or chaperon) a child is unable or should not continue the trip due to disciplinary problems, accident*, injury*, or otherwise the parents will be contacted and arrangements made at the parent's expense to return the child home.
